



What is Revive Family Youth Conference?

Revive Family Youth Conference is a day event where family and friends are invited to join us for family time, food, great speakers, Mass and adoration together as a family.

When will it take place?

Saturday, October 14th 10am-6:30pm. Gates and Registration will be open at 10:00am-1:30pm. There will also be outdoor activities and lunch available until 1:30pm.

Where is it being held at?

St. Mary's Catholic Church (12286 S. Hwy 377 Dublin, TX 76446). Space will be limited so it is encouraged to carpool as much as possible. Parking instructions will be provided as we get closer to the day of the event.

How much does it cost?

\$25 for youth (6th-12th Graders)

Parents and children (5th grade and younger) are FREE

What will be happening during the day?

Besides the fun outdoor activities and food being provided, everyone will have a chance to meet other Catholics from throughout the Diocese of Fort Worth; we will also have amazing keynote and breakout speakers Jackie and Bobby Angel. We will be concluding the day with the Vigil Mass and adoration with our Blessed Lord.

Should I bring anything extra? (i.e. money, supplies, food, etc.)

You are not required to bring anything extra to the day of the event. However, here are some suggested things to bring: A picnic blanket to put out and eat lunch on or just to relax on (Chairs will be limited), any type of games that could be fun for families, extra money as Jackie Francois will have merchandise to sell or if you wish to buy food on the way home (we will provide a going away food), rosary, missal or prayer book during adoration, and a cheerful attitude to meet fellow Catholic families from the diocese!

Will there be a Spanish speaker?

Yes! We were able to bring Joel De Loera to come and speak for any families that speak Spanish only. Joel is the Director of Formation for St. Bartholomew Catholic Church in Fort Worth, TX. Joel will be doing his keynote talk at the same time as Jackie's keynote. There will not be a Spanish track for the gender breakouts.

What if the parents speak Spanish and the kids speak English?

Which keynote should they attend? We will leave this up to the parents to decide. However, if children are younger than 6th grade, they must be with their parents. Youth 6th-12th grade are permitted to go to hear Jackie even if their parents go to hear Joel.

Why should I(we) go to Revive?

We know how demanding the life of a family can be. We understand the constant busyness of people's lives and schedules. We want to offer a short respite from the craziness that is the Fall time and give your family the excuse to be able to spend time together, share a meal with your family and other families, grow in knowledge of the faith, and be able to worship together as a family in Mass and Adoration. Our hope is that your family will be revived and/or refreshed as the domestic church and can continue to grow in faith, hope, and love with one another.

How do I register?

You will need to go through your Youth Minister of your parish. Your youth minister will have a private link to register your parish group and/or to give to families to register themselves. If you are going as a family you can have the option of registering with your parish *or* you can register your family separately and meet on your own there. Youth who won't have their family with them must register with their parish.
