•**The Scholarship(s)** is open to all active members of the Holy Family Catholic Church Parish Family that are seniors in High School. **Exclusively, for incoming freshmen who will be enrolled full-time in an accredited University, College or Trade School in the United States.**

2018 Scholarship Guidelines

Eligibility: Any graduating High School senior who is a confirmed Catholic and a member of Holy Family Catholic Church, and who has been accepted by an accredited University, College, or Trade School as a full-time student, shall be eligible to apply for a scholarship given by Knights of Columbus Council 15882.

Objective: To assist students, graduating from High School, with their expenses during their first year of continuing education enrolled full-time in an accredited University, College, or Trade School degree program in the United States.

Intent: This scholarship is intended to recognize and proclaim students of Catholic faith demonstrating outstanding good works, leadership, and pioneering spirit in young people.

Essay Question: A personal essay on the topic indicated below is required:
Discuss how you live your Catholic faith outside of Catholic institutions (church or school).

GUIDELINES: Essays must be the student's original work. Essays must be typed and be between 150 and 300 words in length.

SELECTION CRITERIA: Applicants for this scholarship shall be judged based on extra-curricular activities (school, community, and Church), completion of the essay question, and academic merit. Council 15882 will evaluate applications in a committee format. There is a maximum of one scholarship award per applicant. The decision of the Selection Committee is final.





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2018 SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION AND DOCUMENTATION: To be considered for this Knights of Columbus Scholarship, the applicant must be a graduating High School senior, a confirmed Catholic, and a member of Holy Family Catholic Church Parish:

1. Complete the prescribed application form. All questions must be answered fully.
2. Please include a copy of your High School Transcript (a photocopy is sufficient).
3. Include a copy of a letter of acceptance from the college or university. If commitment letter is not available at the time of application, the Council must receive a copy of the letter of enrollment before making an award. The award will be distributed directly to the applicant.
4. Deliver all documentation to the administrator not later than the announced date for application. The application should be submitted electronically in PDF format to the administrator. Any application received after this date will not be considered. All entries become the property of the Knights of Columbus and will not be returned.

Submission of Application: Please follow these instructions closely to ensure your application is considered:

1. PLEASE USE THE FILL IN FORM SUPPLIED FOR THE APPLICATION. ALL FORMS MUST BE SUBMITTED TYPED IN PDF FORMAT.
2. YOU MAY USE ADDITIONAL PAGES IF NECESSARY AND SITE APPLICATION SECTION NUMBER.

5. PLEASE DO NOT SEND MULTIPLE EMAILS WITH SINGLE ATTACHMENTS

Scholarship Awards: The Scholarship money will be paid directly to the awarded applicant once enrollment has been verified. If a scholarship is initially awarded but unable to be used (such as the winner not attending or not meeting full time enrollment status) it shall then be awarded to the next-ranked applicant. It is up to the applicant to return award if for some reason they can not attend school in the fall of 2018.
